LESSON: JEREMIAH 7:1-7

1 The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,
2 Stand in the gate of the LORD'S house, and proclaim there
this word, and say, Hear the word of the LORD, all ye of Judah,
that enter in at these gates to worship the LORD. 3 Thus saith
the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, Amend your ways and
your doings, and I will cause you to dwell in this place. 4 Trust
ye not in lying words, saying, The temple of the LORD, The
temple of the LORD, The temple of the LORD, are these. 5 For
if ye thoroughly amend your ways and your doings; if ye
thoroughly execute judgment between a man and his neigh-
bour; 6 If ye oppress not the stranger, the fatherless, and the
widow, and shed not innocent blood in this place, neither
walk after other gods to your hurt: 7 Then will I cause you to
dwell in this place, in the land that I gave to your fathers, for
ever and ever.

EPISTLE: 1 CORINTHIANS 12:1-11

1 Now concerning spiritual gifts, brethren, I would not
have you ignorant. 2 Ye know that ye were Gentiles, carried
away unto these dumb idols, even as ye were led. 3 Wherefore
I give you to understand, that no man speaking by the Spirit
of God calleth Jesus accursed: and that no man can say that
Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost. 4 Now there are di-
versities of gifts, but the same Spirit. 5 And there are differ-

ences of administrations, but the same Lord. 6 And there are
diversities of operations, but it is the same God which wor-
keth all in all. 7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to
every man to profit withal. 8 For to one is given by the Spirit
the word of wisdom; to another the word of knowledge by the
same Spirit; 9 To another faith by the same Spirit; to another
the gifts of healing by the same Spirit; 10 To another the
working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discern-
ing of spirits; to another divers kinds of tongues; to another
the interpretation of tongues: 11 But all these worketh that
one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally
as he will.

GOSPEL: LUKE 19:41-48

come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about
thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,

45 And he went into the temple, and began to cast out them
that sold therein, and them that bought; 46 Saying unto them,

ple sought to destroy him, 48 And could not find what they
might do: for all the people were very attentive to hear him.
