1 And David spake unto the LORD the

rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return

when he cometh, he findeth it swept and gar-
nished. 26 Then goeth he, and taketh to him
seven other spirits more wicked than himself;
and they enter in, and dwell there: and the last
state of that man is worse than the first. 27 And
it came to pass, as he spake these things, a cer-
tain woman of the company lifted up her voice,
and said unto him, Blessed is the womb that
bare thee, and the paps which thou hast
sucked. 28 But he said, Yea rather, blessed are

they that hear the word of God, and keep it.
