1. Dear Christians, one and all, rejoice,
With exultation springing,
And, with united heart and voice
And holy rapture singing,

my office, as a called and ordained servant of
the Word, announce the grace of God unto
all of you, and in the stead and by the com-
mand of my Lord Jesus Christ I forgive you
all your sins in the name of the Father and of
the Son and of the Holy Ghost.

things unto you, sorrow hath filled your
heart. 7 Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is
expedient for you that I go away: for if I go
not away, the Comforter will not come unto
you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you.
8 And when he is come, he will reprove the
world of sin, and of righteousness, and of
judgment: 9 Of sin, because they believe not
on me; 10 Of righteousness, because I go to
my Father, and ye see me no more; 11 Of
judgment, because the prince of this world is
judged. 12 I have yet many things to say unto
you, but ye cannot bear them now. 13 How-
beit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he
